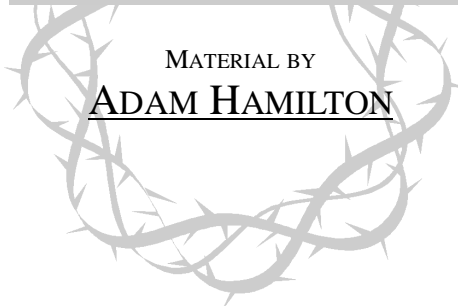


24 Hours That Changed the World
