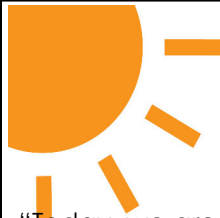

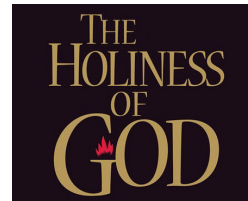

- 102 houses were painted

- 1 youth café built
- 1 park with pavilion
- 141 houses landscaped
- over 19,500 volunteer hours

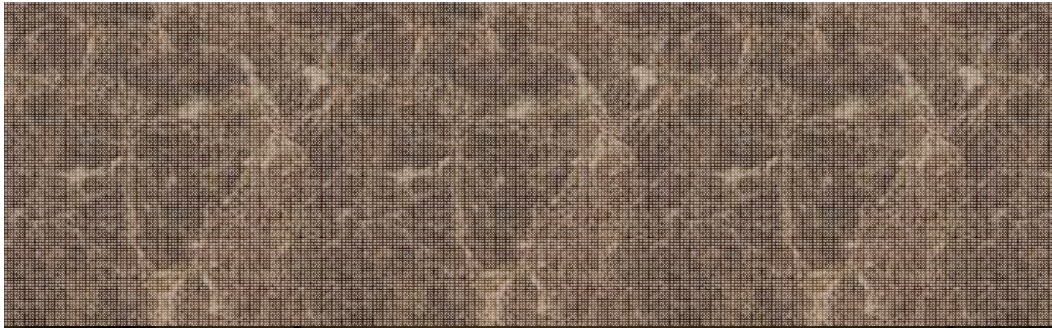
